

CLERK'S REPORT
SESSION MEETING MAY 24, 2011

At the meeting of your Session on May 24, several items were discussed.

Coverage for the interim pastor and associate pastor during vacation and other leave in the summer was discussed and is arranged for.

Vacation Bible School has record applications. We have increased our capacity by 30% and still have children on a waiting list. Priority is given to members.

The financial status of the church for 2011 continues to look solid and year-to-date the cash flow is considerably favorable compared to this time in 2010. Many thanks to our Stewardship and Finance Committees.

Session approved hiring Monty Richards as full-time Youth Director and also a part-time Children's Assistant. Special fund-raising efforts will be made directed primarily to families to cover the costs of the positions through the end of 2011. Next year these costs will be included in the church's budget.

The Presbytery meeting was to be held on May 26. An important item is Amendment 10A to the constitution, changing the language relating to ordination standards. A sufficient number of presbyteries have already passed this amendment that, barring changes in presbytery decisions, it will be adopted on July 10th ..
