

REPORT OF SESSION MEETING JUNE 28, 2011

At the meeting of Session on June 28, the following items were addressed:

Progress has been made on raising funds to pay the salaries for the remainder of 2011 for the new youth director and children's assistant.

Further action with regard to communication about Amendment 10A was deferred until September. A few comments have been received from members of the congregation.

Baptism was approved for William Kroll.

Finances remain healthy, with a good improvement over 2010. The "burn-the-mortgage" committee is optimistic about paying off the mortgage by year-end.

A new curriculum will be introduced for children's education.

The Aid to Education is considering applications for two scholarships.

A mission gift will benefit activities in Guatemala, and will be leveraged with other gifts.

Reverend Hill's contract was extended for one year. It includes provisions allowing termination by the Church or by the interim pastor with notice.

A program is being planned for the tenth anniversary of the September 11 events. An outside speaker is planned, subject to fund availability in the budget.
